## 20th Annual Truckee River Day

Truckee, CA (September 11, 2015) – It's that time of the year, time to grab those gloves, shovels and boots and bring family and friends to help restore our Truckee River. Our 20<sup>th</sup> annual Truckee River Day is Sunday, October 18<sup>th</sup>.

Volunteers have their choice of half or full day restoration projects with different levels of difficulty. There will be 10-12 projects including restoration at Dry Creek in Russel Valley, seeding and mulching at Johnson Canyon, milfoil surveys in Martis Valley, and revegetating near Boca Townsite. Projects start at 9 a.m. or 11 a.m. and finish between 2 p.m. and 3 p.m.

The River Fair will be from 1 p.m. to 4 p.m. at Granite Flat Campground. This community event is presented in partnership with Sierra Watershed Education Partnerships. The fair features fun environmental activities for kids and adults. Food will be provided free of charge by Northstar California. Everyone is invited to the fair even if you're not involved in restoration projects.
