



# Middle Martis Creek Project Area



#### Problems addressed


- Channel undersized for moderate flows
- Incision, erosion, and headcutting in Middle Martis Creek
- Meadow impacts
- Highway 267 flooding
- Access road and trail impacts





#### Project History

- Identified through
   Martis Watershed
   Assessment 1 of 20
   projects
- Top priority for stakeholders





#### TRWC's role

- Each landowner addressing separately
- Problem too large for single entity
- TRWC identified root cause
- Brought landowners together





#### Project Partners

- Caltrans
- Northstar California/Vail Resorts
- Northstar Community Services District
- Truckee Donner Land Trust
- Truckee Tahoe Airport District
- Truckee River Watershed Council
- U.S. Army Corps of Engineers



#### Solution

- Restore peak flows to north side of highway
- Split flows at existing culvert
- Maintain base flow on south side of Highway



### Project Benefits

- Restore 40 acres wetland
- Improve 1 mile stream habitat & 2 acres riparian habitat
- Improve water quality
- Enhance fish and wildlife habitat
- Reduce infrastructure impacts

# Project Timeline

Phase	Completion
Watershed Assessment	April, 2012
Concept Design	December, 2012
Final Design	December, 2014
Permitting/Environmental Compliance	July, 2016
Pre-project Monitoring	August, 2016
Post-project Monitoring	July, 2019



#### Project Elements

- Split flow at existing culvert
- High flows to north
- Base flows stay in existing channel


