Truckee Wetlands Restoration Project Presentation 1/28/14

Truckee, CA (January 9, 2014) – The community is invited to join the Truckee River Watershed Council for a presentation on the Truckee Wetlands restoration project on Tuesday, January 28th from 6 to 7:30 p.m. at the Cedar House Sport Hotel.

The Truckee Wetlands are a fragmented wetland complex starting at the Hilltop area near Cottonwood Restaurant, interrupted by Old Brockway Road and Estates Drive, re-starting near the Martis Valley Estates neighborhood, and eventually connecting to main stem of the Truckee River. The wetlands are not fully functioning, but can be reconnected to provide water quality and habitat benefits.

Please join us to learn more about the Truckee Wetlands and opportunities for restoration. Project design will be completed in 2014 and implementation is planned for 2015.
