






What was the problem?

- Fragmented wetland complex
- None of the wetlands are fully functioning
 - Disconnected hydrology
 - Significant storm runoff
 - Significant erosion
 - Inappropriate land use







Hydrologic Alterations



Erosion and sedimentation





Floodplain alterations





Feasibility Study

- <u>Surface flows</u> should be used to restore hydrology
- Recommendation: restoration was possible





Restoration within constraints

- Altered hydrology
 - Focus on only impaired areas- avoid functional habitat
- Infrastructure to remain
- Land use to continue
- Focus on restoring function not acres.





So what's the plan?

Spring to river



Restore floodplain

Improve road

> Reestablish historic channel

Re-grade pond edges

RUC

Fill ditches and disperse flows

Remove artificial fill and

reestablish topography

Expected outcomes

- 9 acres of wetland enhanced
- 1.4 acres of historic wetlands re-established
- Improved hydrologic connectivity and function
- Improved pond management for irrigation & wetlands
- Reduced erosion & sedimentation

• Total Cost: \$2.1 million


