REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS:

NEPA COMPLIANCE FOR TRUCKEE RIVER WATERSHED RESTORATION PROJECTS

The Truckee River Watershed Council (TRWC) is developing wetland and stream restoration projects in partnership with federal land management agencies in the Truckee River watershed. In 2018 and 2019, TRWC may be assisting these partner agencies to complete the National Environmental Protection Act (NEPA) for these projects. Our federal partners include the US Forest Service (USFS), US Army Corps of Engineers (USACE), and US Bureau of Reclamation (USBR). TRWC requests standard statements of qualifications (SOQ) from consultants experienced in completing NEPA compliance for the USFS, USACE, and/or USBR.

SOQ REQUEST – Please Describe

- Firm or team's qualifications in NEPA compliance.
- Experience completing NEPA documents for the USFS, USACE, or/and USBR. If possible, highlight experience with these agencies California locations.
- Highlight experience in developing Categorical Exclusions determinations, Environmental Assessments, and/or Findings of No Significant Impact.
- Highlight examples of completed agency NEPA decisions.
- Examples from restoration projects are preferred but not required.
- Preferred length for the SOQ is 3-4 pages, with an optional cover letter.
