	Question: Why has water been released from Tahoe that is, at times, above the minimum amount requested for recreational rafting? It seems some of this water would be able to be reserved during a dry season for additional release later in the season to benefit fish and aquatic populations.
	Tahoe is anticipated to be below the rim in late summer, early fall of 2022. This means no additional water is available for release. There may be a possibility to work with the Watermaster in future years to maintain water in Tahoe for late summer/early fall releases that would benefit fish

	and aquatic populations, but ultimately once Tahoe is below the rim, there is no ability to release additional water.
